



**Smuggler's Plane Wreck**  
(Depth: 50-130 ft)  
A small, four-passenger plane, long thought to be an ill-fated drug smuggler's final stop, rests in 70 feet of water.

The fuselage is broken in half but the nose, cockpit and passenger compartment are still semi-intact, now adorned with a variety of sponge and soft coral growth. You will find grouper, snapper and the remainder of the usual suspects – but it is also the haunt of at least one very large Loggerhead Turtle.

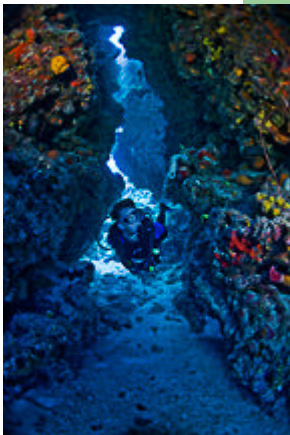
**Tunnel Rock**  
(Depth: 20-50 ft)

Tunnel Rock offers a great cavern cutting through the primary coral head in a broad reef field. The primary opening, oblong in shape, is found at about 55 feet in depth. Enter there, descend past a ledge and then slope down through the long tunnel to emerge through an irregular opening at 70 feet. The interior is rich with maroon calcareous algae and a broad variety of small sponges. Near the exit the ceiling drips with long and delicate whip corals.

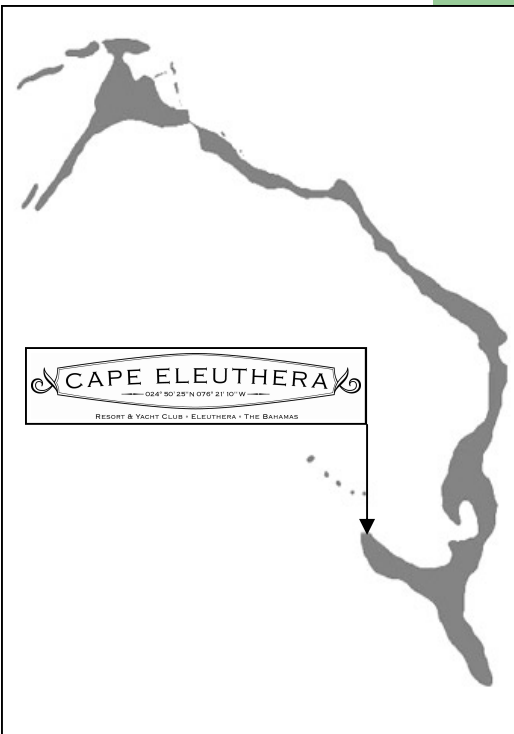


**Hole in the Wall**  
(Depth: 40-130 ft) :

A crevice in the reef at about 75 feet opens into a tall, roomy tunnel leading out to the broad expanse of the Exuma Sound. With the sand floor of the exit at 98 feet, this is a moderate deep dive over the wall. The tunnel is encrusted with deep-hued calcareous algae, inhabited by numerous fish and adorned with a variety of sponges. After emerging from the tunnel into the deep blue of the Sound take time to explore the sponge-laden vertical face of the coral wall.

**Ike's Reef**  
 (Depth: 10-40 ft)  
 A field of scattered coral mounds, many reaching to within 8 to 10 feet of the surface. A casual dive and typical of the shallower reefs, it is a nice introduction to the mid-depth areas of Cape Eleuthera. Expect mid-size reef fish such as grouper, snapper, small schools of grunts, the occasional turtle, Southern Stingrays and a relatively common inhabitant, a small Spotted Eagle Ray meandering through the coral heads.

**The Fish Cage**  
 (Depth: 50-130 ft)  
 Situated right on the wall, this open water aquaculture cage was planted by the Island School and used as research for the school's marine biology program. This cage has the most spectacular fish aggregation of all the dive locations. African pompanos, amberjacks, bull sharks, hammerhead sharks, and some of the largest grouper you have ever seen! To the north and the south the wall begins more shallow and invites exploration.



**Rock Sound Blue Holes**  
 (Depth: 15-130 ft)  
 A short trip north will bring you to the Rock Sound Blue Holes, a series of three irregularly-shaped, oblong openings into the subterranean heart of Eleuthera. Grouper, snapper, lobster, crab and other inhabitants may be found hiding under ledges and in crevices. The view of the sun-dappled surface from the interior is magnificent.

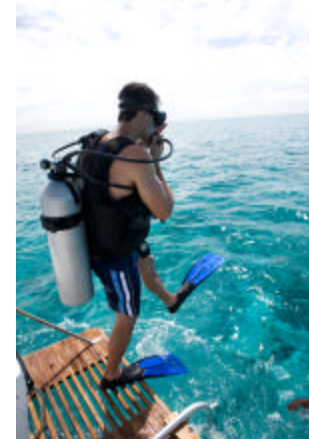
